- 1. Describe the clearing. What does George tell Lennie about this place?
- 2. Give 3 identifying characteristics of Lennie and 3 for George. How do they interact with each other?
- 3. What dream do Lennie and George share? Recount at least 3 details.
- 4. Describe the bunk house. How does this fit into the life of a rancher?
- 5. Who are Candy and Curley? Do they approach George and Lennie in the same manner? Explain.
- 6. How does Lennie feel about the ranch? What are some of the things he likes? What are some of the things he dislikes?

- How does their relationship set George and Lennie apart from the others?
- How does their dream set them apart?
- How do George and Lennie each view their dream of owning a farm someday?
- Do they share the same goals, desires, and needs?
